You WILL NOT be able to come to the office to apply for a [purchase](#) or [concealed handgun](#) permit or pick-up any issued permits. We will mail all approved purchase and concealed handgun permits to your home address. The good news is we are going to continue to process applications during this time and you can still apply online for permits. We appreciate your understanding during this time and look forward to opening our offices to you once this crisis is over.
