The Mecklenburg County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) is scheduled for a virtual-based assessment as part of a program to achieve accreditation by verifying it meets professional standards administered by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA), the accreditation program requires agencies to maintain compliance with state-of-the -art law enforcement standards in four basic areas: policy and procedures, administration, operations, and support services.

Street in Charlotte, North Carolina 28202. Masks will be required, and social distancing guidelines will be in place.

Telephone comments, as well as appearances at the public information session are limited to 10 minutes and must address the agency's ability to comply with CALEA's standards.
