In-Custody Death of Mecklenburg County Sheriff's Office Resident

(CHARLOTTE, NC) - The Mecklenburg County Sheriff's Office is currently investigating the death of 51-year old Michael Daniel Mangan (PID # 484192), a resident housed at Detention Center – Central (801 E. Fourth Street). Mangan was found unresponsive in his cell at approximately 5:38 a.m. this morning. After CPR was performed by staff and first responders Mangan was pronounced deceased at approximately 6:23 a.m. this morning.

Mangan was brought into MCDCC on Friday, July 10, and did not display any symptoms of COVID-19. He was not yet placed in general housing as all non-symptomatic residents are placed in Pod 3200 for five days prior to being reassigned. SBI will continue a thorough investigation as the medical examiner determines the cause of death.

"We are devastated by the loss of Mr. Mangan," stated Sheriff McFadden, "anyone who enters our facility is apart of our detention community and I am deeply sadden; our condolences are with his family."
