The Mecklenburg County Sheriff's Office Community Engagement Team consists of detention officers and deputies who bring different operational perspectives and diverse background which provide a better overall experience for the citizens of Mecklenburg County. The mission of the CE Team is to broaden partnerships between the community and the Sheriff's Office, educate the community on the Sheriff's role, provide outreach, and to purposefully engage those that we serve to establish trust and confidence in the Sheriff's Office.



# Our Project

**Shop with a Sheriff** is a one-on-one experience designed to have uniformed officers spend a day of shopping and engaging with underprivileged students in Mecklenburg County during the Christmas season. Each child is partnered with an officer to shop for toys, clothing or items of their choice. This program is developed to form a positive relationship between officers and the community but most importantly the program allows underprivileged children the opportunity to enjoy Christmas.





Students are selected from different communities in Mecklenburg County by means of local schools. With the help of teachers and community leaders, we will identify children who would be good candidates for the program and send home applications to be completed by their parents. Once the applications are received, children who best qualify to participate are selected. The total number of children selected will be decided based on funds available.
